

Ostinato™ Laminated Glass - Allegro Wood Veneers

Made Proudly in the USA

Ostinato™ Allegro - This idea surfaced when we developed the Ostinato™ method of lamination, utilizing only one sheet of glass on the surface layer of the composition.

In an effort to introduce wood veneers laminated at a cost savings, we use standard species of wood veneers that are readily available for immediate lamination in glass. The grade of veneer is usually pretty nice. As the veneer sheets are produced in mass for quick ship orders, they are produced flitch run. Once they've run one flitch, they begin the next. Sheets may or may not then, be in sequence. They may also include different slicing methods because the whole focus is on yield from the flitch.

Standard Species Include: (these are in stock and can be shipped to us for lamination immediately)

Ash - Flat Sliced and Qtrd Material

Red Oak - Flat Sliced, Quartered and sometimes Rift Material

White Oak - Flat Sliced, Quartered and sometimes Rift Material

Maple - mainly Flat Sliced

Walnut - Flat Sliced and some quartered material

Birch - mainly rotary sliced

Hickory - mainly Flat Sliced

Mahogany - Flat Sliced and Quartered, most likely Khaya (African Mahogany)

Sapeli - Quartered Only

Once received, we can laminate within a week to 10 days.

This is the most cost competitive level of our laminated glass, production offerings. It is meant to offer wood as a viable material for surfacing, laminated into glass. Sequence is not required.
